Serco Welfare to Work is part of the Serco Group. It works with the Department for Work and Pensions to deliver the Flexible New Deal, designed to help unemployed people get back into work.

The company's success meant they needed to move to larger premises in Charing Cross, London. They asked Orchard to look after the ICT side of the move by installing a fully operational office for 48 people over the course of a weekend.

We began work on the Saturday morning. Working with existing cabling and infrastructure, we supplied and installed switches, internet connection, servers and printers as well as moving all the company's existing PC's and providing connections for laptops.

When staff arrived first thing on Monday they were greeted with a fully functional office. After moving in their own personal bit and pieces they were up and working again by 11 am.

Originally we were given three weeks to complete the project. However, circumstances changed and the deadline was brought forward by two weeks. Unfazed, we managed to complete the job in just two and a half days.
